Food/Drink Booths Only

- 1. All food vendors MUST bring a 5 lb. ABC fire extinguisher. The Huntsville Fire Department will be given a list of vendors and will have a representative check for this fire extinguisher and will also be checking propane tanks to make sure that everything is up to safety regulations. This is for food vendors that will be cooking on the premises.
- 2. Remember that spaces are 10 x 10 only. PLEASE <u>do not bring a trailer, etc</u> <u>larger than this unless you have purchased an additional space!</u> This includes the tongues on trailers.
- 3. Food booths <u>MUST</u> obtain a health permit from the City of Huntsville. You may obtain the permit by calling (936) 294-5717 or you may access the form on the web at <u>www.huntsvilletx.gov</u>. If vendor falls under <u>Cottage Food Law</u> please review rules and regulations at the above website.
- 4. There will be ONE electrical outlet per booth for food vendors ONLY that have prepaid. You must supply your own extension cord (100-150 feet should reach depending on location of your booth. Outlets are behind F29 and F14) to accommodate the space between your booth and the outlet. Only 120 V/20 amps GFI is available, no 220!
- 5. If you have requested and pre-paid for water you MUST bring your own water hose to hook up. You will need to bring at least a 100 ft hose (depending on your location)! If you are using water in food preparation be sure that you use a FOOD SAFE HOSE!
- 6. Food vendors MUST catch any excess grease drippings, this will NOT be allowed to run off on ground.

ALL GREASE MUST BE DISCARDED PROPERLY. DO NOT POUR GREASE INTO DRAINAGE AREAS IN THE PARKING LOT. ANY VENDOR NOT FOLLOWING THIS RULE MAY BE FINED AND/OR PROHIBITED FROM PARTICIPATING NEXT YEAR.

7. ALL food vendors that use a barbecue pit MUST protect the asphalt underneath from heat and grease drippings!
